\$ 15,993.67 - Plus monies received for Funds for Specific Purposes

\$189,257.17 - Total Available

\$179,134.36 - Less Expenses (Salaries, Utilities, Shares of Min., Improvements, Ins., etc.)

\$ 10,122.81 - Net amount that each Fund Balance increased or decreased.

Current Balance in **General Operating Fund** is \$32,444.40.

Current Balance in **Funds for Specific Purposes is \$49,083.67** not including the growth fund. These monies include gifts to Maintenance & Repairs, Memorials, Missions (Hungry for More), Kitchen Maintenance, Sound System, Choir Music, Scholarship Fund, Cemetery Fund, Etc.

Additionally this year you have very generously given \$650.00 to Ruth's Harvest, \$800.00 to the Scouts, \$300.00 to Camp Scholarships, \$3,215.29 to UMCOR, \$100.00 to Heifer International and \$316 for the AED.




